



Welcome to the Jefferson Health Plan. Effective January 1, 2021, the Hardin County Consortium and its seven member school districts will join the Jefferson Health Plan (JHP).

The Jefferson Health Plan is a council of governments established in 1985. Currently, the JHP membership includes over 22,000 public employees and their families. The JHP membership includes school districts, cities, townships, villages, counties, and other governments in the State of Ohio. The JHP offers the benefits of group purchasing for medical, prescription, dental and vision insurance.

The following is a brief summary of the move to the Jefferson Health Plan effective January 1, 2021:

1) Medical Coverage

- Medical Mutual of Ohio (MMO) will remain as the third-party administrator (TPA).
- MMO will be issuing new ID cards for everyone. These cards will be sent directly to the employee around the first week of December.
- Coverage will remain the same.

2) Pharmacy Coverage

- RxBenefits will administer the prescription coverage.
- ESI (Express Scripts) will remain as the pharmacy benefit manager.
- RxBenefits will issue new, separate ID cards for everyone. These cards will be sent directly to the employee in mid-December.
- Coverage will remain the same.
- Existing prescriptions will carry over to the new RxBenefits plan.

3) Dental Coverage

- Dental coverage will continue to be administered by Delta Dental.
- No changes will be made to the coverage or ID cards.

4) Vision Coverage

- Vision coverage will continue to be administered by VSP.
- No changes will be made to the coverage or ID cards.
