

Robert P. Wildman Scholarship

Criteria:

- This scholarship applies to structured education or training that can prove a passing grade was achieved and provides a specific path toward employment. Students interested in farming, mechanics, machinists, repair services, construction, plumbing, electrical, cosmetology, accounting, office, managerial, and many other fields are encouraged to apply. It's aimed at helping those seeking education and training to augment a work experience or opportunity. Those following the traditional path of college education are also eligible to apply.
- Hardin Northern Graduating Senior; proof that a 2.0 grade or higher was received, qualifying them for graduation.
- Maximum Scholarship amount is \$1,000.00. Scholarship Donor reserves the right to determine the number and dollar amount based on Applicant data, interviews and Donor's choice.
- Application for scholarship is due March 22, 2024 to Mr. Wilson at Hardin Northern High School.
- Once approved further education is completed, student submits proof of attendance and passing grade to Hardin Northern High School Counselor, and Scholarship Committee. A check will then be sent to the learning institute.
- Scholarship recipients are to attend and be recognized as a Hardin Northern school scholarship winner.
- If chosen for this scholarship, the student agrees to contact donor at least twice per school or class time frame, sharing their address and learning experiences with the scholarship Donor.
- If interviewed, the applicant will create and share a payment plan and potential money source that identifies how they intend to pay costs that may not be covered by this scholarship. For example, Cost of class/classes, housing, books, tools/equipment, and other fees that are anticipated to be above and beyond scholarship amount.
