Hardin Northern High School Physical Education Waiver

All students are required to receive one half unit of credit of Physical Education in order to graduate from Hardin Northern High School. This one half unit is completed over two semesters with successful completion of each semester receiving one quarter units of credit. Typically, at HN, the first semester is taken as an 8th grader and the second as a 9th grader.

The Hardin Northern Board of Education has adopted a policy that allows a student to waive one of the two semesters of PE by participating in interscholastic athletics, marching band, or cheerleading for at least two full seasons. Note: this does not give ¼ credit for PE but instead waives the need to take a second PE course. Students still need to a minimum of 21 credits to graduate.

All students choosing to waive a PE course must complete this form upon completion of two seasons of interscholastic sports, marching band, or cheerleading and submit it to the guidance office. NOTE: students can do any combination of two. All waivers must include a parent signature and the signature of the coach/advisor for each season completed signifying the requirement of participation has been met.

Again, all students must still complete PE 1 with a passing grade (typically as an 8th grader) but can waive

PE 2 with this form.
